

## DIRECTOR'S NOTES:

Drawing upon Indian folktales and myths, Karnad creates super-natural worlds where he poses universal and philosophical questions. *Naga Mandala* symbolically portrays how a woman's power emerges through the metamorphosis of a serpent, and her paradoxical sub-version of patriarchal control. While Karnad's work speaks to many traditions embedded in India's pre-colonial performance history, he simultaneously engages us to reevaluate our thinking and practices about social inequalities in contemporary culture.

The mandala (circular disc), representing the universe, also encompasses the different worlds from which emerge the various characters and their stories: Man, the Flames, and Rani's Story. As the site of magic, the mandala helps further "a play within a play" format, continually (re)defining space and time.

My sincere thanks to the entire company of *Naga Mandala*, and to my colleagues in the School of Theatre & Dance.
